Construction is now underway at Illinois Avenue Apartments, a 38-unit affordable rental community for veteran households in Beaumont. These new apartments will be home to homeless veterans with a disability, chronically homeless veterans, and veteran families in Riverside County. LINC also celebrates the beginning of construction at Diamond Street Apartments in Anderson, which will become 45 new apartments for low-income families.

Job Training with GRID Alternatives

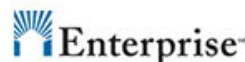
