### Taking Flight

Construction on The Nightingale in unincorporated Los Angeles County, a 29-unit supportive housing community for those who have experienced homelessness, is progressing on schedule. LINC's construction management team reports that framing is complete on the first and second floors and third floor framing is underway. In partnership with Electric Power Research Institute, LINC is working to incorporate Zero Net Energy features such as solar PV generation, upgraded sustainable construction methods, and high efficiency equipment and appliances.



### Ready to RUN to the Polls

LINC is partnering with RUN on voter engagement and registration efforts at LINC communities to raise awareness and support for important statewide ballot initiatives, such as Proposition 1, the [Veterans and Affordable Housing Act](#). Launched in 2014, The Residents United Network (RUN) — a project of Housing California and the Center for Community Change — trains residents living in affordable housing communities to become self-advocates to help advance a housing justice platform.
