### November 2 -- Vote YES on 22!

Do you want to protect our redevelopment funds? The State Legislature took and borrowed \$5 billion last year from various local funds to balance the state budget and is planning to take billions more this year. State raids have forced deep cuts to local budgets.

**LINC and others stand behind Proposition 22.** A YES vote on 22 will stop state politicians from taking or borrowing local tax dollars dedicated to cities and counties to fund affordable housing, 9-1-1 response, transportation, and other vital services.

The community is currently undergoing major renovations to include environmentally friendly features and site improvements for greater handicap accessibility.
